## **Message from the Executive Director**

## Dear Colleagues:

On February 25, 2014, Governor Christie delivered his proposed Fiscal Year 2015 budget to the New Jersey Legislature. Once again, the Governor has shown his strong support for New Jersey's premiere need-based student aid program, the Tuition Aid Grant (TAG). TAG funding is proposed at approximately \$355 million, which includes an increase of \$14 million over the current fiscal year.

At the February HESAA Board meeting, the Board adopted a budget policy statement for Fiscal Year 2015 recommending that TAG awards be increased by a flat percentage. If approved, this would eliminate the current model based on tuition levels of two years prior (neediest students) and four years prior (all other students), less a percentage to stay within budget.

With a base plus structure, instead of looking back at previous tuition levels, TAG tables would start at a base year beginning in FY 2014-2015. Each NJEI cell would increase by a set percentage annually, not to exceed full tuition at a public institution, or 50 percent of the average tuition at an independent institution as required by statute.

The Governor's budget endorsed the HESAA Board's recommendation and proposes a two percent across-the-board increase to all award levels at all institutions.

My team and I look forward to preparing for these hearings and testifying on behalf of TAG and all the important student aid programs HESAA administers.

## NJCLASS Now Processing Loans for AY 2014-2015




HESAA is now processing NJCLASS loan applications for the upcoming academic year. Pre-approved loan applications will remain active and will not be cancelled if school certification is pending.

# **HESAA Training Can Help Reduce Defaulted Student Debt**



## **Compliance and Quality Assurance**

## **Due Diligence Advised in Choice of Third-Party Providers**

Compliance failures could expose an institution to critical review from the USDE and jeopardize institutional Title IV funding.



Recent regulatory enforcement actions involving institutions of higher education around the country highlight the importance of exercising due diligence when it comes to an institution's decision to partner with external service providers.

Of particular concern are third-party contracts for online coursework not directly controlled or governed by the institution itself. Similarly, the control issue applies to schools that partner with banks to provide students with financial services. The Consumer Financial Protection Bureau has been increasingly critical of those arrangements, which can lack transparency and raise concern that students could be liable for unanticipated fees and charges.
